## DEVOTION: JOHN 2:13-22

**13** It was almost time for the Passover Festival, so Jesus went to Jerusalem. **14** There in the Temple he found people selling cattle, sheep, and pigeons, and also the moneychangers sitting at their tables. **15** So he made a whip from cords and drove all the animals out of the Temple, both the sheep and the cattle; he overturned the tables of the moneychangers and scattered their coins; **16** and he ordered those who sold the pigeons, "Take them out of here! Stop making my Father's house a marketplace!" **17** His disciples remembered that the scripture says, "My devotion to your house, O God, burns in me like a fire." **18** The Jewish authorities came back at him with a question, "What miracle can you perform to show us that you have the right to do this?" **19** Jesus answered, "Tear down this Temple, and in three days I will build it again." **20** "Are you going to build it again in three days?" they asked him. "It has taken forty-six years to build this Temple!" **21** But the temple Jesus was speaking about was his body. **22** So when he was raised from death, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they believed the scripture and what Jesus had said.

### Monday 4 March 2024

### Tuesday 5 March 2024

Search our hearts, test our minds and our ways, and see if we bear fruit that will last. Purge us with hyssop, and we shall be clean; wash us, and we shall be whiter than snow (Ps.51:7). Teach us wholehearted abandonment to You, give us hearts after Your heart (Acts 13:22) for we know that Your enemies will become our enemies and will flee before us. Amen.

### Wednesday 6 March 2024

**Let us pray:** Father, as Your church in South Africa, we confess that often we serve two masters. We try to work out a way to serve You and mammon (riches). We cover our greed by saying we want to make money for the church, we withhold Your share of our income, and if we are really honest, we desire money more than we long for You. Our hearts are cold and greedy. Forgive us O Lord. Give each of us a heart of flesh, a heart seeking You alone. (Matthew 6:24). Please transform Your Church through the blood of Jesus Christ, Your Son. We pray that those of us who preach the Gospel may stand firmly in the will of God, that we will be spiritually mature and obedient (Col.4:12). We pray for a church that will cry out to You night-and-day so that You will not keep putting us off (Lk.18:7). We pray for a mighty healing for all people, that as we look with fresh eyes on our world, we would seek You in all things. Amen.

### Thursday 7 March 2024

**Let us pray:** Lord Jesus, we pray for our country, the world and all leaders. We pray that unfair and godless leaders will make "mistakes" that will be to the advantage of the Gospel. We pray that oppressors and godless leaders will lose their positions of power by means of wrong advice. "Confuse the wicked, O Lord, confound their speech, for I see violence and strife in the city" (Ps.55:9). Remove bad rulers and appoint God fearing persons instead. Lord, disrupt the advice of evil advisors at government level and give our leaders wisdom and discernment. Holy Spirit, break the strongholds of the Evil One in politics and the evil plans of Satan in the hearts of people in positions of authority. We pray especially for the leaders in countries where there is bloodshed, violence, chaos and anarchy, that they will tire of these evils and seek for peace and stability. We ask all this, in Jesus' Name. Amen.
