DEVOTION: MARK 4:26-34

26 Jesus went on to say, "The Kingdom of God is like this. A man scatters seed in his field. **27** He sleeps at night, is up and about during the day, and all the while the seeds are sprouting and growing. Yet he does not know how it happens. **28** The soil itself makes the plants grow and bear fruit; first the tender stalk appears, then the head, and finally the head full of grain. **29** When the grain is ripe, the man starts cutting it with his sickle, because harvest time has come. **30** "What shall we say the Kingdom of God is like?" asked Jesus. "What parable shall we use to explain it? **31** It is like this. A man takes a mustard seed, the smallest seed in the world, and plants it in the ground. **32** After a while it grows up and becomes the biggest of all plants. It puts out such large branches that the birds come and make their nests in its shade." **33** Jesus preached his message to the people, using many other parables like these; he told them as much as they could understand. **34** He would not speak to them without using parables, but when he was alone with his disciples, he would explain everything to them.

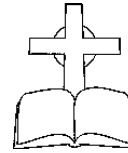

Father, we renounce all foolish jealousies and small ambitions. Teach us how to give ourselves continually to prayer and the ministry of the Word. Amen.

Wednesday 19 June 2024

Let us pray: We pray for Your Church. Father, even our best intentions to serve You are at times corrupt. Please forgive us. Create in us a fear of the Lord. Let the Church once again become a good shepherd to Your flock. Let us serve as overseers - not because we must, but because we are willing to, not out of greed for money, but in eagerness to serve You, not lording it over those entrusted to us, but rather being examples to them. Father, we confess that we do not know Your Word on the issues of life. We think that if something seems in order with us, it would naturally be in order with You. Father, the fear of man has become a snare to many in the Church; we seek the favour of people of influence. Stir in the Church an understanding that the only true justice is Your justice. Let the Church understand that You made known to us the mystery of Your will according to Your good pleasure, which You purposed in Christ, to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfilment—to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, Christ Jesus. Amen.

Thursday 20 June 2024

Let us pray: Lord, we ask that the pursuit of our lives would not be to gain material possessions. We ask that You would grant us the grace and power to love You and pursue You above all else. We give You thanks for Your goodness, care and provision for the congregation and for all those who have something to give. Jesus, we pray also for those who do not have anything to give, asking God's blessing in their lives, that they might also be able to provide for others. Friday 21 June 2024

Let us pray: Gracious Lord, we lift up our families, our homes, single-parent and Youth led homes. Today we pray specifically for our children, our own and other children we know personally. We also pray for neighbours' children, children in our local schools, friends of our children, the children of acquaintances and street children. Lord, You made them and formed them in their mother's womb and want to engrave their names in the palms of Your hands (*Isa.49:16*). Lord Jesus, we pray that God's Spirit of power, love and self-discipline will fill each and every one of our children. Lord, we plead for their physical safety and care. We pray for a hunger and a thirst in the hearts of our young people, that they start praying together, and have a greater desire to read and pray from the Word. So also Lord, do we pray for the safety and care for street children. Merciful God, we lift to You the lives of street children. Rescue them and be their refuge. Amen.

Saturday 22 June 2024

Meditation: Glory to our ascended Lord that He is with us always. Glory to the Word of God, going forth with His armies conquering and to conquer. Glory to Him who has led captivity captive and given gifts for the perfecting of His saints. Glory to Him who has gone before to prepare a place in His Father's home for us.
